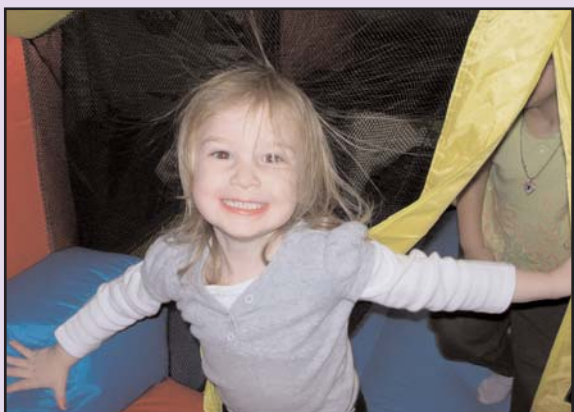
Gear Up for Snow Play
